CPRI has reached another milestone by receiving an order worth Rs 83.68 lakhs from Chamundeswari Electric Supply Company (CESC) to monitor RGGVY programme at Chamrajnagar and Madikeri Districts of Karnataka.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by Shri V N Nandakumar, AD (Admn) on behalf of CPRI and Shri H Nagesh, CE (O&M) on behalf of CESC on 25th April, 2008 at CPRI, Bangalore in the presence of Shri P K Kognolkar, Director General CPRI, Shri M M Babu Narayanan, AD (R&D), CPRI and T Raghunatha, Joint Director, CPRI. RGGVY programme was launched by Govt. of India to provide access to electricity to all rural households in five years for the attainment of goals of the National Common Minimum Programme (NCMP).

CPRI has been appointed as Supervision and Monitoring agency for RGGVY works in Chamrajnagar District and Kodagu District of CESC, Karnataka and Idukki District of Kerala. The work involves project monitoring and supervision of quality of works during construction. The work shall be carried out as per the guidelines of REC.
